*Project partners develop **automatic machine translation**, combining the statistical paradigm with deep linguistic techniques. The translation system will be adapted to the domain and integrated into the live system run by NHS 24 and Cochrane.*

It will support morphologically rich languages, such as those found in central and eastern Europe.
